**NTPC SAIL POWER COMPANY LIMITED (NSPCL)** invites online bids through GeM Portal on **“Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding basis (Envelope-I: Techno-commercial Bid & Envelope-II: Price Bid)”** from eligible bidders for aforesaid package, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.

**1.0 BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK**

The scope of work comprises **Engineering, procurement, supply, erection, commissioning & handover work for Mulsifier/emulsifier system of Transformer yard transformers & Turbine Main Oil Tanks of PP-II, NSPCL Bhilai**

**Applicable.**

Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with Udyam as specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises as per MSMED Act 2006, for goods produced and services rendered, shall be issued the bid documents free of cost and shall be exempted from paying Earnest Money Deposit.

The award shall be made as follows:-

- a) Award shall be given to L1 bidder if L1 bidder is a MSE.
- b) In case L1 bidder is not a MSE, then all the MSE vendor(s) who have quoted within the range of L1 + 15%, shall be given the opportunity in order of their ranking (starting with the lowest quoted MSE bidder and so on) to bring down its price to match with L1 bidder. Award for full quantity shall be placed on the MSE vendor who matches its price with L1 bidder at the price quoted by L1 bidder.
- c) If no MSE vendor who has quoted within range of L1+15% accepts the price of L1 bidder then the award shall be made to the L1 bidder.

The benefit as above to MSEs shall be available only for goods/services produced & provided by MSEs for which they are registered.

MSEs seeking exemption and benefits should enclose a attested/self certified copy of valid registration certificate, giving details such as validity,

	stores/services etc. failing which they run the risk of their bid being passed over as ineligible for the benefits applicable to MSEs.

1.1	The bidder should have experience of execution for Designing/erection/commissioning/maintenance of fire Fighting System equipment's / Fire Detection system/Emulsifier system/ Fire Hydrant System pipeline network and meeting any one of the following criteria within preceding (Seven) 7years as on the date of techno-Commercial bid opening in any for the following manner: a) One (1) order of value not less than Rs. 111.12 lakhs (inclusive of taxes) OR b) Two (2) order of value not less than Rs. 69.65 lakhs each (inclusive of taxes) OR

	c) Three (3) order of value not less than Rs. 55.56 lakhs each (inclusive of taxes)
	<p>NOTES for clause 1.1 above:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Documentary evidence like executed PO copies, proof of execution of order, copies of MB (bills/receipts) etc. shall be submitted by bidder.</li> <li>2. In case of composite contracts, a bidder has to give the breakup of composite PO value.</li> <li>3. Bidder must submit NISC/SSI/MSE registration certificate, if applicable.</li> <li>4. The word executed means that the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in the qualifying requirements with any of the following conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) Case-I: The work is started earlier (prior to the period stipulated in clause 1.1) but completed within the stipulated period as mentioned in clause 1.1. 2.0	<b>Financial Criteria:</b>
2.1	The average annual turnover of the Bidder, should not be less than 138.90 lakhs (Indian Rupees One crore Thirty-Eight lakh and Ninety thousand only) during the preceding three (3) financial years as on the date of techno-Commercial bid opening.
2.2	In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of techno-Commercial Bid Opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from a practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of techno-Commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.
	<b>NOTES FOR FINANCIAL CLAUSE 2.0 ABOVE:</b>
	1) Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirements stipulated hereunder:

5.0 Any Certificate(s) / Financial Statement(s) / Audited Balance Sheet and P&L Account (wherever applicable) undertaken/ signed by a Member of Institute of Chartered Accountant of India (ICAI), which Bidders submit in support of compliance to Qualifying Requirements (QR), will carry Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) generated in line with the Gazette Notification of Council of Institute of Chartered Accountant of India (ICAI).

6.0 Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to assess the credentials/capabilities/capacity of the Bidder/ his collaborators / associates/ subsidiaries / group companies to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.

The physical or any mode of assessment/verifications by Employer shall include but not be limited to the assessment/verifications of office/ facilities/ banker's/ submitted reference works in lieu of credentials. A negative determination of such assessment of credentials/capacity/capabilities may result in rejection of the bid.

7.0 The reference works whose details have been declared in their bid shall only be considered to ascertain the bidder's compliance to the specified qualifying Requirement (QR). The Employer at its discretion may seek any clarification and/or documentary evidence only for the reference works as mentioned above. However, no change or substitution of the reference works by new/additional plant for conforming to the specified qualifying Requirement shall be sought, offered or permitted".

8.0 'Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. **The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.**

9.0 Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects.

10.0 NSPCL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids/NIT without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

11.0 The bidding document is available online. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested Bidder from the [GeM](https://gem.gov.in) Portal (<https://gem.gov.in>). The Bidder would be required to register on the website.
